#### **Excerpts from Glenn Beck - December 17, 2010**

**Talking about his visit to Wilmington, Ohio:** *"The TV show was just magic...the show, television show was about miracles and there were three miracles I think that happened.*

*There is a company that is correcting people's hearing, and I don't mean like with a hearing aid or anything else. I had these two wonderful women in my office on... Monday right before I went on the plane. And they were in my office and they had both had their hearing restored, not enhanced. Restored. And it's an incredible piece of hardware. I mean, it's just, it's amazing... you put it in and then it has to heal for eight months and it's actual restoration of hearing, not like a cochlear implant... I get to Wilmington, Ohio, and what were*

*there? About 2,000 people in line at the bookstore... In that crowd there were, let's see, a mom, a dad, and this son. And he was about, probably 7 or 8. And he had hearing aids... After hearing this story on Monday from these two women, I could -- I just, I knew what he was feeling. And there was Miracle Number 1.*

*Here I am, I know this technology exists. I know this family probably doesn't know about this technology and I just don't think they could afford it. It's \$30,000 an ear. And we can. And I looked at them and I thought, that is not a coincidence that they were sitting in my office on Monday and I know about this and now I see him, and I know we can restore his hearing... we're going to do it.*

*When I got off stage somebody told me that, again on a handshake, business comes to town from North Carolina. They had heard us talking about Wilmington... If you want to help this town out, still the [Wilmingtongeneralstore.com](http://www.wilmingtongeneralstore.com) still has all of the shops and stuff that you can go and buy something from... I didn't get a chance to meet this family that is living in a... one-room apartment with another family and they are so destitute that they go to the Wal-Mart to warm up, and they opened up a storefront yesterday and they were selling anything they could get their hands on, used records and everything else... It's just amazing, amazing people that did whatever they could to be able to find something of value that maybe somebody would want for Christmas. Instead of just standing there wanting a handout. Wilmington, Ohio. Thank you. Thank you for giving us the Christmas spirit. Thank you for showing us the way out."*
